Honor Roll**

Rationale

Honor Roll is a recognition of effort and results for students who meet challenging and rigorous achievement goals.

This is the proposed Honor Roll methodology for all students in grades 6 -8. All courses will count toward the middle school honor roll. It will be noted at the end of each trimester at the middle schools. All high school course will be eligible for consideration for honor roll.

Methodology

1. Students on the honor roll:

Cumulative Average (Rounded to Hundredths)

Middle

Highest Honors:	(95 - 100)	(No C, D, F, or Inc)
High Honors	(88 - 94.9)	(No C, D, F, or Inc)
Honors	(80 - 87.9)	(No C, D, F, or Inc)

2. Honor Roll is for grades 6 - 8.
3. Final grades of each course taken.
4. Students must have an "M" for MEETS or "I" for INCONSISTENTLY MEETS under Social Behavior and Work Habits to be considered eligible. (Middle School Only)
5. Middle School related arts courses/specials are averaged in as a single course.

Students and parents will be notified through a letter from the Principal. Additional recognition may be decided by each school through educators, parents, and school councils.
