Extended School Year (ESY)

- Service provided beyond the traditional school year for students with disabilities who need special education and related services to extend their educational program in order to receive FAPE.
- A program for which ALL students with disabilities must be considered, regardless of the degree and/or type of disabilities.
- Services are provided based on a decision by the IEP TEAM on an annual basis.
- Data is collected during vacation periods (summer, holiday, winter and spring breaks) to determine if the student experiences a demonstrated regression — recoupment pattern(s) when there are breaks in instruction.

ESY Implementation

A multitude of various services are provided over 24 summer days:

- ❖ Academics/Related Service Interventions

Reading, Writing, Math, Speech, OT, PT, Counseling

- ❖ Specialized Programming (Monday-Thursday)

Academics, related services are provided daily
