

Participants:

Upperclassmen students from the advanced German classes will be invited to participate in this field trip. Participation is limited and will first be opened to students in German 4, followed by students in German 3.

Students from other German programs across New England have been invited to participate. Teachers and chaperones from seven other high schools are coordinating and providing supervision over the participants.

Objective of the Trip:

The objective of the trip is two-fold. First, students will learn more about opportunities and possibilities for applying German in their personal, professional and academic lives. Second, high school students will work with university students and professors on hands-on STEM experiments, while using the target language (TL – German).

This field trip supports the education and occupation themes in our curriculum as well as providing an opportunity for students to use and develop their German skills outside the classroom.

An example of one of our follow up activities is a unit on “Jobs and Occupations.” In this unit, students research internships, scholarships and jobs. They write resumes and application letters in German as well as practice interviewing for a job. Resources they gather from the Career Booster Day will be used in completion of this unit.
